Issues published

The most recent issue is 38 (2017-2018), which contains the Proceedings from the Conferences in 2017 and 2018 according to the new procedures agreed at last year's AGM.

Issues planned

- Volume 39 (2019) should be a regular issue. We are expecting two regular contributions to come in soon. We hope to also include a number of delayed book reviews.
- Volume 40 (2020) will include the Proceedings from the current Conference in the new format agreed to last year (same as issue 38).

The University of Lethbridge, through the Journal Incubator project and the School of Graduate Studies, has supported CJNS with \$8,600 annually for editorial assistance. As the editorship will go into new hands this year the UofL support will also end.

The only permanent expenses related to the journal are our CALJ membership and cost related to the website.

We decided not apply to SSHRC's Aid to Scholarly Journals program last year.
